
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














#### Mission

4.To inspire students to care for and better serve the well-being of the international society.








### **Curriculum Framework**






### **Graduation Thesis**

- 1. The topic should relevant to journalism and mass communication.
- 2. By individual student or in a group of 2-5 students.
- 3. The minimum requirement for thesis by individual student is 8,000 words and 12,000 words for group work.
- 4. Thesis supervisor should be full-time or part-time faculty at MCU.
